We have a busy half term planned in Reception, full of music, dancing, creativity and self-expression! As always, we will continue to share our learning on Seesaw, and you can still contact us either in person at the beginning or end of the day or through the Key Stage One office.

Reception Curriculum Information

English: Children will continue to apply their knowledge of Little Wandle Letters and Sounds with increasing accuracy and independence. Although there are no new sounds to learn this half term, we will be reviewing all of the Phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs that we learnt in Spring 1 and begin to apply these sounds to our writing with increased independence. We will begin to learn how to read longer words ending in -s, -es and -ing.

Maths: We will continue to use subitising skills to explore and deeply understand the composition of numbers within 10. We will be finding more or less than a given number, both practically and using a visual representation. We will be playing games and completing practical activities to develop counting and estimation. Children will continue to solve simple practical addition, subtraction & division problems while broadening their understanding of vocabulary and language linked to Maths.



Curriculum Focus

Reception will continue with our over-arching theme of 'I can reach great heights.' This term we will be exploring music and dance from different cultures. We will take inspiration from the music we listen to, to create artwork and put on performances linked to our learning. This will link to our school values of being "brave" and "ambitious". We will also continue to develop our understanding of seasons in Science and begin to learn about simple life cycles. These are just some of our key texts for the half term...
