Curriculum Focus

English: This half term, we will be studying the book "The Guardians of the Wild Unicorns" by Lindsay Littleton to inspire our learning. We will be building up to writing our own narrative extract from an adventure story. We will be recapping some of the features of direct speech, using subordinating conjunctions and practicing the author technique of showing not telling when describing character's feelings and reactions.

Maths: In maths we will be working on units of measurement, including area and perimeter. We will then be moving onto fractions. We will be working on recognising and representing families of common equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.
