Curriculum Focus

English: We will be focusing all of our learning around the book 'The Eye of the Wolf' by Daniel Pennac. We will be focusing on writing and recording an information text based on the wolf's physical attributes, habitat and lifestyle. In our second piece related to 'The Eye of the Wolf', we will be focusing on how to discuss and share a balanced argument. We will continue to focus on expressive vocabulary, spellings and grammar within our writing.

Maths: This half term, we will be working on the topic of Fractions (including decimals and percentages). Some of the areas covered include; comparing and ordering fractions; identifying, naming and writing equivalent fractions; recognising mixed number and improper fractions; adding and subtracting fractions; multiplying proper fractions and mixed numbers; rounding decimals with two decimal points and reading, writing and ordering numbers up to three decimal points.
