Curriculum Focus

English: This half term, we will be writing to inform based on 'Arthur Spiderwick's Field Guide'. We will study a range of magical creatures from the field guide using our reading behaviours. Then we will look at different author techniques and apply them to our own writing. We will follow the writing process by planning, writing and editing our own field guide entry based on a magical creature that we created ourselves.

Maths: In Maths, we will be beginning our unit on 'Fractions'. We will be looking at unit and non-unit fractions then comparing and ordering unit fractions and fraction with the same denominators. We will recognise how tenths are formed and count up and down in tenths. We will also learn how to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within one whole and use all of this knowledge to solve fraction problems.
