Curriculum Focus

English: This half term we are going to focus on the text 'Peter Pan'. Then we are going to look at 'Peter Pan' in a different way with the purpose of writing to persuade, trying to persuade our audience to either be a pirate or a lost bou!

Maths: In maths we will be working on multiplication and division. We will be focusing on our times tables up to 12x12 and counting in multiples of 6, 7 and 9. We will explore factor pairs and multiply and divide two and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using a formal written layout.
