Curriculum Focus

English: This half term, our text will be Cloudbusting by Mallorie Blackman. This is a fantastic book, written in different styles of poetry and focusing on friendship and bullying. We will be using it to create a diary entry from the perspective of one of the characters. We will then write an informative piece in the form of a news report about a key incident in the story.

Maths: In maths, we will be working on fractions and decimal numbers. We will be looking at recognising and representing families of common equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator. We will also look at recognizing and writing decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths.

Science: States of matter - can materials change from being solids, liquids and gases?

Art: Art and design skills - paint, print, sculpt and tone
