Curriculum Focus

English: This half term we will be focusing on revision of our grammar and punctuation skills, using a range of stimulus such as images, video clips and short extracts. We will be refreshing our knowledge of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions. Mastering apostrophes for contraction and possession. Practising and embedding more challenging punctuation such as commas, speech, and exclamation marks. We will then be applying these skills to our first persuasive text, 'The Sports Manager.'

Maths: In Maths we will begin by looking at Number and Place Value. We will recognise the value of each digit in a four-digit number and represent these in different ways, using concrete resources and pictorial representations. We will look at counting in multiples of 25 and 1000 and finding 1000 more or less than a given number.

History: How have children's lives changed?
