Curriculum Focus

English: This half term we will be focusing on story settings and character descriptions. We will be exploring new vocabulary and using adjectives in our written work. The children will continue to develop their oracy skills through performance in Talk Through Stories where we will be investigating monster characters in the book 'Gotcha!'.

Maths: We will begin by looking at shape and the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, before moving on to fractions. The children will find $1/2$, $1/3$, $1/4$ & $3/4$ of shapes and amounts.

We are also focusing on times tables, developing children's fluent recall of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We would appreciate your support to practice learning them at home through the activity packs provided and playing TTRS regularly.
