Curriculum Focus

English: This half term, we will be writing with two outcomes; firstly to provoke an emotional response, then to inform. Our key text will be 'Dream Giver'. We will be building up to writing our own narrative about a dream. We will recap the use of fronted adverbials to add detail to our writing and also consolidate the range of punctuation that has been taught this year.

Maths: We will continue our work on time, focusing durations of time, before studying properties of shape. We will be identifying acute and obtuse angles, comparing angles and recognising straight angles. We will start to classify shapes based on their properties and size, identify lines of symmetry and complete a simple symmetric figure.
